Mr. Ollie Stansel, age 91 of Lovelady, passed away Tuesday, Nov. 2, 1999, at the Diagnostic Hospital in Houston. Mr. Stansel was born Sept. 10, 1908, and had been a resident of this area most of his lifetime. He was a retired maintenance supervisor with Lovelady ISD and was a long time member of the Lovelady VFD serving as their first fire chief.
