## Steve Starling

TRINITY - Services for Steve Starling, 83, of Trinity were held at 10 a.m. Friday, Oct. 28, 2005, at the Brookside Funeral Home in Houston.

Burial followed in the Brookside Memorial Park.

Mr. Starling died Wednesday, Oct. 26.

He was born Sept. 16, 1922, and until his retirement he was a lifetime resident of Houston. He served with the Houston Fire De-

partment for 28 years.

He served for three years with the U.S. Army during World War II and was stationed in Germany much of that time. He was honorably discharged in December 1945.

Mr. Starling and his wife, Jynell, had a love of adventure which brought them to Trinity. Here they became members of the Marina Village Resort in 1977, which later influenced them to retire to Trinity.

He was an active member of the Trinity County Veterans of Foreign Wars Post No. 6899 of Trinity.

Survivors include his wife of 63 years, Jynell Starling of Trinity; one daughter, Wanda Riley of Mt. Pleasant; three sons and their spouses, Melvin and Cora Starling of Humble, Howard and Sandra Starling and Glen and Linda Starling of Trinity; 12 grandchildren; and 24 great-grandchildren.
