### **William Lee Starling**

Funeral services for Mr. William Lee Starling were held Saturday, August 3, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. in the Callaway-Allee Memorial Chapel with Rev. Frank Oswald and Rev. Carl Standley officiating. Interment followed in the Ivie Cemetery.
