

Streetman Rites Held Last Week In Palestine

Services for Pick H. Streetman, 74, of Palestine were held Wednesday, November 24, at the Herrington/Land of Memory Chapel, Palestine, with D. P. "Skipper" Worsham officiating. Burial followed at the Land of Memory Cemetery.
