Mr. Milton Earl Thomas, age 87 of Crockett, passed away Monday, August 23, 2004 of natural causes in Crockett. Mr. Thomas was born June 7, 1917 in Blairstown, Missouri. Mr. Thomas's family moved to Houston when he was two years of age. Mr. Thomas was a long time resident of Bellaire until his retirement to Crockett in 1991.
