Mrs. Mary Ruth Anthony Story Thompson, age 79 of Midland, passed away Monday, September 26, 2005. Mrs. Thompson was born Lubbock on November 26, 1925 to Josiah Foster Anthony and Mary Caigle Anthony. Mrs. Thompson graduated from Lubbock High School in 1943. While attending Texas Tech, she was a Tech Beauty and a member of the LaChap Social Club.

Mrs. Thompson married James Richard Story on February 2, 1946 and had two daughters. After Mr. Story's death in 1988, she wed Joe L. Thompson on November 24, 1990. Mrs. Thompson was a loyal member of the First United Methodist Church of Midland, where she served on the board of directors, the building committee and the pastoral selection committee.
