1938, in Nacogdoches County, she was the daughter of William Hall Johnson and Leura L. Johnson.

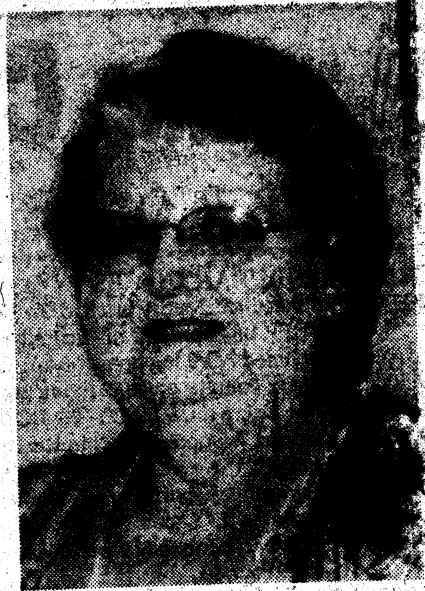
