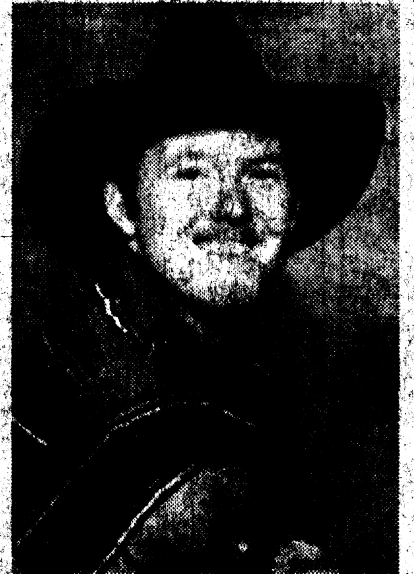
He also was known as a kind, generous and thoughtful man who enjoyed cooking for his many friends.
