REVEREND OLEN TROUTMAN

Reverend Olen Troutman, age 84 of Baytown, passed away September 15, 2006 in the St. Luke's Hospital in Houston. Reverend Troutman was born December 27, 1921 in Purcell, Oklahoma and had resided in Baytown since 1948.

Reverend Troutman served in World War II where he flew in foreign missions for the Army-Air Force from 1944 to 1946. Reverend Troutman retired from Merchants Fast Motor Freight and went into full time ministry in 1953.

Reverend Troutman first began his ministry as a co-pastor with Reverend Lonnie Bowlen at Northside Assembly of God in Baytown. Reverend Troutman then went on to pastor The Lighthouse Assembly of God in Baytown, First Assembly of God in Livingston, Rusk Assembly of God, Glad Tidings Assembly of God in Palestine and served as interim pastor of the First Assembly of God in Crockett on two separate occasions.

Reverend Troutman was an ordained minister through the Assemblies of God. After semi-retiring from the ministry, he went onto the evangelictic field where preached in many churches in South, North and East Texas. Reverend Troutman ministered the precious word of God for over 50 years. At the time of his departure, he was a member of the Victory Temple in Baytown under Dr. Charles Kyle, beloved pastor and friend.
