## Joy Elizabeth Humphrey Tucker

TRINITY - Services for Joy Elizabeth Humphrey Tucker, 72, of Trinity were held at 2 p.m. Saturday, March 5, 2005, at the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home Chapel in Trinity.

Burial followed in Clapp Cemetery.

Mrs. Tucker died Tuesday, March 1, 2005, at Avalon Place Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Trinity.

She was born March 23, 1932, the fourth child of Albert "Bud" and Ruby Wiggins Humphrey. She attended public school in Lovelady and graduated from Trinity High School.

Mrs. Tucker began her career with Southwestern Bell telephone as an operator in 1950 and retired after 30 years of service in the position of business office supervisor. While working for Southwestern Bell, she took a sabbatical and earned her bachelor of business administration degree from Dallas Baptist University.

She married her husband of 48 years, Jeff A. Tucker, while both were working in the Huntsville area. Most of their married life was spent in the Dallas-Fort Worth area and in 1990 they relocated back to Huntsville.

Mrs. Tucker was preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Albert Thomas Humphrey; and a sister, Azlee Bell.

Survivors include her husband; a sister and her spouse, Betty and Troy Krenek of Garwood; a brother-in-law, Ziggy Tucker of San Antonio; five nieces; and three nephews.
