Mr. George Washington Tulllos, age 78 of Pennington, beloved husband, father and friend, passed away Thursday, January 27, 2005, after a courageous battle with lung cancer. Mr. Tulllos was born March 9, 1926 in Pennington to Wash and Lillie Tulllos.

Mr. Tulllos was a farmer until he was called into service in World War II where he proudly served in the US Army from April 1944 until May 1946 and served valiantly, receiving numerous medals, including a Purple Heart for wounds received in Europe.
