William "Bill" Turnbull

TRINITY -- A memorial mass for William "Bill" R. Turnbull, 85, of Houston and Trinity was celebrated at 1 p.m. Thursday, June 29, 2000, at the Most Holy Trinity Catholic Mission in Trinity with Father Joseph Felix officiating.

A second mass was celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Friday, June 30, at St. John Neumann Catholic Church in Houston with Monsignor Eugene Francis officiating.

Mr. Turnbull died June 27.

He was born March 15, 1915 in

Peterborough, England. He was a member of the Royal Canadian Air Force, Charter to K of C, the Order of Alhambra and was a retired vocational teacher with the Houston Independent School District. He also was a member of Painters Local No. 130 and of the Trinity Peninsula Evening Lions Club.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Shirley Turnbull and by a daughter, Lynda Cox.
