Mrs. Walker died Saturday, Dec. 11, 2004, at the Avalon Place Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Trinity.

She was born Sept. 20, 1915, in Kimble County, the daughter of Mary Mathida Apelt and Melvin Custer Hull. She was a maternal descendant of the Leifeste and Apelt families and the paternal descendant of John Taylor Hull, all early Hill County settlers.

On Oct. 9, 1938, she was married to Chadley George Walker in the Kerrville. The couple resided in the Saline community in Menard County near London until 1962 when they moved to Fredericksburg. Mr. Walker died in 1994 and one year later Mrs. Walker moved to Houston.

A lifelong Presbyterian, she was a member of the Memorial Presbyterian Church in Fredericksburg and was active in church work and in her children's school activities. She was Worthy Matron of both the London and Fredericksburg Order of the Eastern Star chapters. At the time of her death, her OES membership was with the Kerrville chapter.

She was preceded in death by her sister, Lorena Rutherford; and three brothers, Howard Hull, Harvey Hull and Melvin M. Hull.

Survivors include a daughter and son-in-law, Mary Ellen and Dr. J. Frank Thornton of Trinity; two sons and two daughters-in-law, George and Pamela Walker of Colorado City and Dr. John and Regina Walker of Houston; a sister and brother-in-law, Ella Mae (Maisie) and Sammie Bruce of Junction; two sisters-in-law, Rosa Lee Hull of Milford and Minnie Walker of London; five grandchildren and their spouses, Robert F. Thornton of Tyler, Elizabeth and Chad Cavitt of Austin, George and Sidney Levesque of Abilene and Emily Walker and Whitney Walker, both of Houston; two nephews, nine nieces; and one nephew-in-law.
