## Ernest James White

TRINITY – A memorial service for Ernest James White, 58, of Huntsville was held at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 7, 2005, in the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home Chapel in Trinity with the Rev. Warren Austin officiating.)

Mr. White died in Houston on Friday, April 29.

Born Oct. 21, 1946, in Birmingham, Ala, he was the son of Ernest Columbus and Martha Wingo White.

He served in the U.S. Army for over 10 years, including three tours in Viet Nam. He was wounded three times and was awarded three Purple Hearts, a Bronze Star and a number of other medals and citations for his military service.

Mr. White was an assistant warden in the federal prison system and was most recently employed with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice as an assistant to the deputy director in construction.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his son, Ernest James White II.

Survivors include his wife of 20 years, Angel White; one son,

Ernest James White III; two daughters, Ann White and Lynn White; his stepfather, Elijah Gilmore; his mother and father-in-law, Judith and John Ferguson; four brothers, Joe White, Roger White, Bobby White and Lee White; and a sister, Charlene Perry.
