

Troy Overton Whitesides

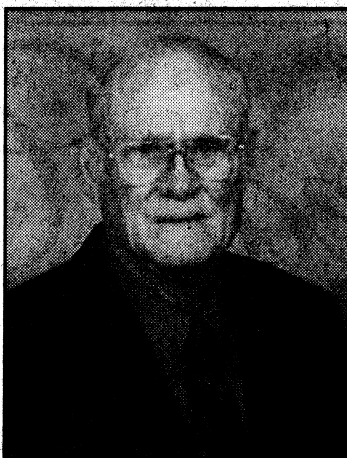
