



**SALLIE WOODWARD**

Mrs. Sallie Woodward, age 78 of Houston, formerly of Crockett, passed away Sunday, December 8, 2002 in the Spring Shadows Pine Nursing Home in Houston. Mrs. Woodward was born December 28, 1923 in Grapeland and lived in Crockett for many years until moving to Houston. Mrs. Woodward had served as public librarian to Houston County citizens for 12 years. Mrs. Woodward was a past school teacher and school librarian. Upon the graduation of J.D., her youngest, from Crockett High School, she decided to pursue her education, full time, at Sam Houston State University, where she earned a Bachelor's degree in Education and a Master's degree in Library Science. Mrs. Woodward maintained the Dean's list throughout her education and was listed in Personalities of the South, in 1972, at the height of her education. Mrs. Woodward dedicated her life to building a public library that people in Houston County can be proud of and tell their grandchildren about. Mrs. Woodward started at the Crockett Public Library October 1, 1973 and retired October 31, 1993.

Survivors include her sons Jack Woodward and wife ~~Sally~~, and J.D. Woodward, III and wife Linda, all of Houston; grandchildren J.D. Woodward, IV, Jennifer Woodward, and Stephanie England, all of Houston; sister Aretes Lambert, of Dallas; several nephews and one niece.
