grant's land. Perhaps this explains the discrepancy between the 640 acres (if married) and 320 acres (if single) given him as a conditional grant and the 320 and 160 acres mentioned in his German Immigration Contract.

A photostatic copy of one of the land transfer contracts (that of Heinrich Staats) is shown in Plate 12. It was witnessed by Henry F. Fisher and notarized by DeCordova for the State of Texas.

Appendix III

SHIP LISTS

The names of immigrants on sixty-one ships from Europe and fourteen ships from ports in the United States were indexed in an effort to get as complete a list as possible of the Germans who came to Texas during the years 1844-1847. Of the ships that sailed from Bremen, all reached Texas except the *Nahant* which was shipwrecked on the coast of England. Its passengers continued their voyage on other Verein ships, most of them coming to Texas on the *Timoleon*. A list of these ships has been compiled from two main sources:

Important information to be found about an immigrant in a ship list includes: port and date of departure, port and date of arrival in Texas; his residence in Europe, often his age and profession, the maiden name of his wife and names of his children, if known, and sometimes the record of his death when this occurred en route.

A copy of the German list (partial) of passengers on the Riga and also a copy of the Republic of Texas list (partial) may be found in Plates 14 and 15.
