


"High Flight"

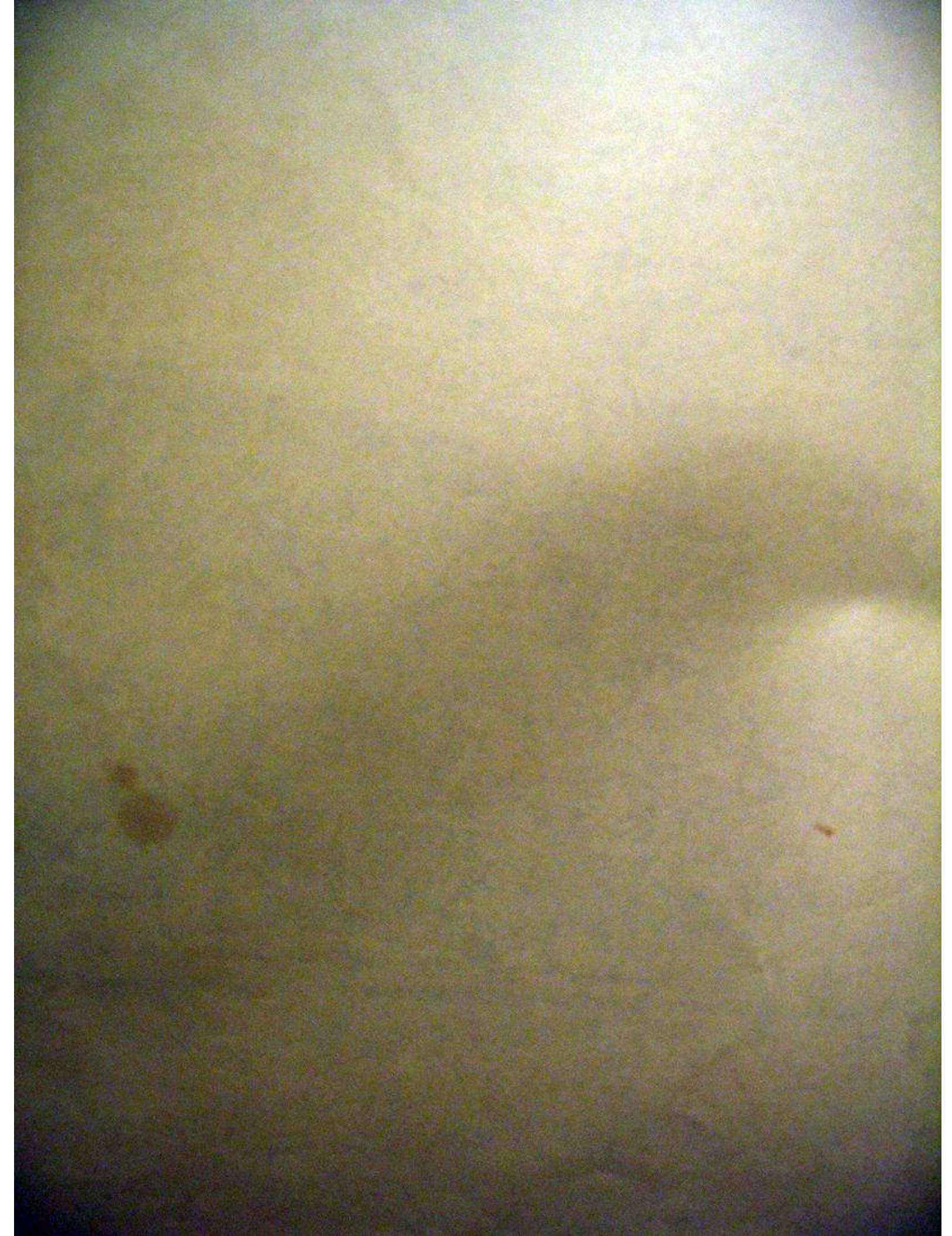
Oh, I have slipped the surly bonds of Earth

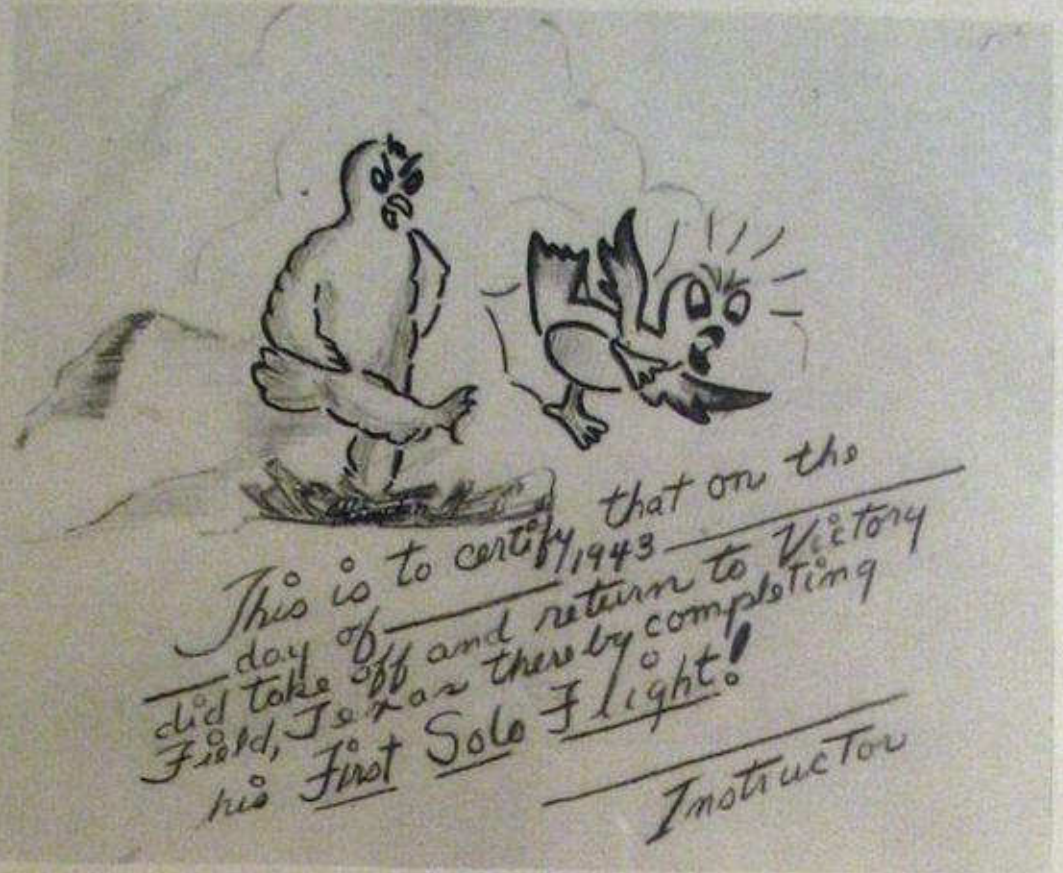
As the target comes nearer, and the fighters slide up, and the guns start their chatter, I know this is where I belong . . . this is what matters . . .
